1 decorative button of

Steps To Complete



Instructions:

Soak the lace pieces in warm water for about 15 minutes to remove most, but not all, of the stabilizer. You want them to retain some stiffness.

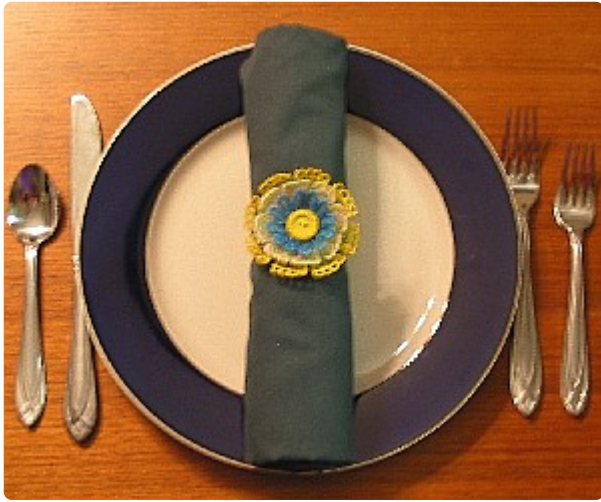
Blot on a paper towel to remove most of the water.

Shape the petals as you desire and allow the pieces to dry completely.



Arrange the pieces with the largest on the bottom, the medium next then the smallest. Arrange so that they are centered as you like. Place the button in the center, and stitch through all the layers to secure them all together.

Tie the ends of the elastic together to form a loop. Attach the loop securely to the back of the lace flower.



Place the flower on top of a rolled napkin, and stretch the elastic around the napkin to fasten.
